
Should I send my child to school?

- Yes! Even if they are feeling slightly sick, try to send them to school.
- If a child is vomiting or has a fever, please keep the child home. A child must be fever-free for 24 hours before returning to school.
- If your child stays home, please contact the FRES Attendance line at fresabsence@hcpss.org or call the school at 410-880-5950.

HOWARD COUNTY POLICY ON ABSENCE

- To report your child's absence you may call the front office or send an email to fresabsence@hcpss.org.
- "The school must receive a note, handwritten or emailed, from the parent or physician explaining the absence/tardiness of a student within two school days of the student's return or the absence/tardiness will be unlawful/unexcused. When a doctor's certification for chronic illness has been required and not provided within two school days of the student's return, the absence/tardiness will be recorded as unlawful/unexcused until a doctor's certificate is provided."


What should my kindergartner wear?


Choice Time

Children are counted to 3 when doing a behavior that needs to be stopped.


If the teacher counts to 3, the child is given a time out.

- Do not rely on Kindergarten Teachers to check emails during the day. Please call the office if your child is going home differently.
- Teachers will respond to emails within 24 hours of a workday.
