Report Cards

- Students will continue to receive letter grades on their report card

Homework

- Students will be given reading and math homework Monday through Thursday
- Homework should take about 40 minutes
 - Students should read for 20 minutes each night and have a parent/guardian sign off on their agenda book after they have completed it
 - Math homework will be given from the math teacher
